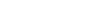

Hungry Ghost Festival

July - August 2024

Location: Penang

The Hungry Ghost Festival or Phor Thor during the seventh lunar month is celebrated on a grand scale in Penang. This year this highly anticipated event in Penang falls between 29 July - 26 August. So if you happen to be on the island during this time and looking for things to do in Penang, then be sure to say hi to our supernatural friends! The Hungry Ghost Festival celebrates the month on which the gates of hell are believed to be opened for them to roam freely.

During this time, you will get to see makeshift altars erected along the roadsides, and giant joss sticks being lit and food being offered to appease wandering spirits and ghosts. Staged operas are also conducted for the entertainment of ghosts, spirits, and the public on a nightly basis.

FESTIVALS & EVENTS

The Penang Yosakoi Parade

14 September 2024

Location: George Town

The Penang Yosakoi Parade is a vibrant festival with its lively celebration of Japanese culture infused with local Penang elements. The event will take place at the Esplanade, Padang Kota Lama, and surrounding areas in George Town, Penang.

Mid-Autumn Festival

17 September 2024

Location: Multiple places

Mid-Autumn Festival is celebrated widely in Penang. It is a time when family and friends gather to admire the full moon while savouring Moon Cakes, Chinese tea and parading around with colourful Chinese Lanterns.

Penang Dragon Boat Festival

23 November 2024

Location: Teluk Bahang Dam

Held at the Teluk Bahang Dam, this festival features exciting dragon boat races with teams from around the world competing to the rhythm of beating drums.

Penang Bridge International Marathon

15 December 2024

Location: Sultan Abdul Halim Muadzam Shah Bridge An annual marathon event that takes place on the Penang Bridge. It is one of the longest bridge marathons in the world and attracts runners from all over the globe. It includes multiple race categories including a full marathon, half marathon, and 10K run. Participants run across the iconic Penang Bridge. offering a unique running experience.

Nine Emperor Gods Festival

September - October 2024

Location: Penang

During this period, devotees would practice a strict vegetarian diet to "cleanse" their body and soul. According to old Chinese belief, the Nine Emperor Gods are spiritual mediums believed to dwell in the stars in heaven, and on the eve of the ninth moon, temples of the deities like the Tow Boo Kong temple at the end of Jalan Raja Uda in Seberang Perai will hold a spiritual ceremony to welcome them.

George Town Literary Festival (GTLF) is recognized as one of Southeast Asia's largest literary festivals, celebrating literature, translation, and the literary arts.
