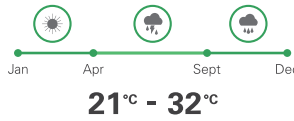

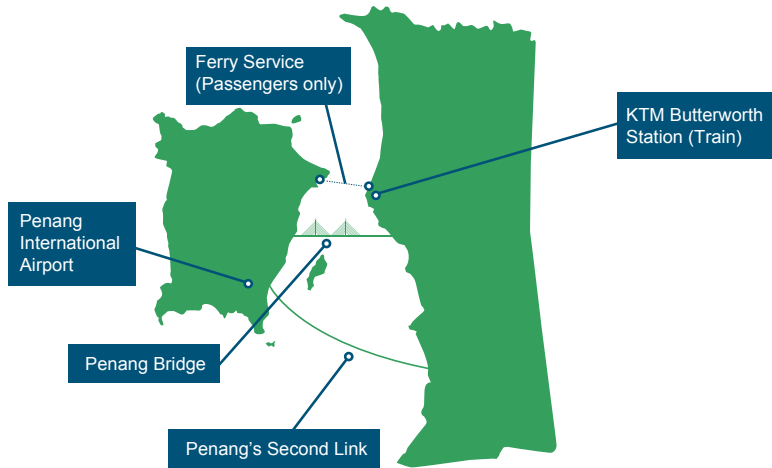

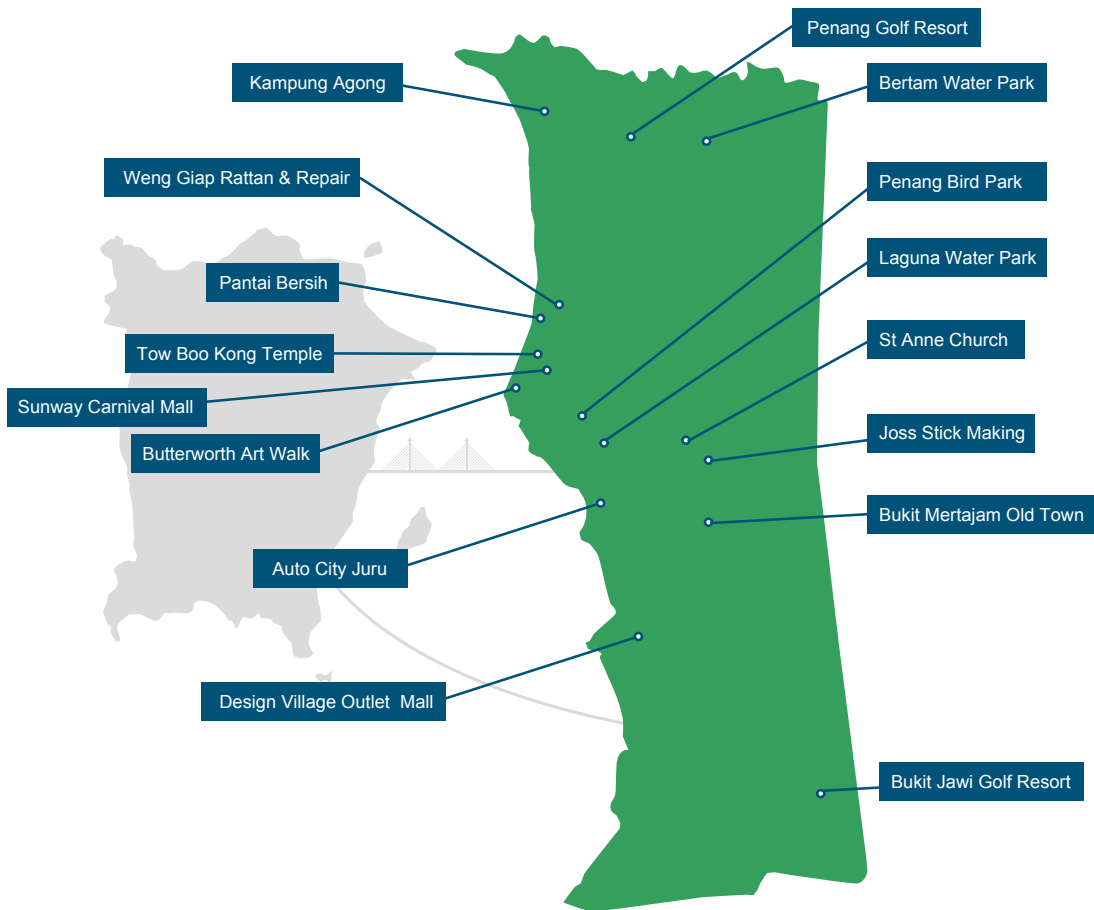

Butterworth Art Walk

Butterworth Art Walk

The Butterworth Art Walk is a product of Penang's vibrant artists and rich history. Striking murals and installations are meant to educate visitors about the mainland's tumultuous past. Seberang Perai's history of farming and elephant export is one of the interesting facts you can learn while walking the small streets of Jalan Bagan Luar. Who would have thought a story could be a whimsical backdrop for a photo!

Exploring Kepala Batas

Located on the mainland, Kepala Batas is a hidden gem waiting for your visit. Nestled on the banks of the Sungai Muda and with Kedah's Gunung Jerai in its backyard, this town offers spectacular views of rice paddies and traditional Malay Kampong houses, offering a glimpse into the country's prehistoric civilisations.

Charming Bukit Mertajam

Located in the middle of Seberang Perai, Bukit Mertajam is a former farming village. A walk through the old town of Bukit Mertajam will give you a glimpse of Malaysia's vintage history. The vine-covered walls and rickety wooden windows of Bukit Mertajam's shophouses are a sight to behold, giving the town a rustic old-world charm.



Hungry Ghost Festival

Nine Emperor Gods Festival

The Nine Emperors Festival is mainly found in Southeast Asia and is celebrated for nine days in the ninth month of the Chinese lunar calendar. In Penang, the main temple to witness this fascinating festival is at the Temple of the Nine Emperors or Tow Boo Kong at the end of Jalan Raja Uda in Seberang Perai.

Hungry Ghost Festival

The Hungry Ghost Festival is one of Penang's largest and most spectacular Buddhist festivals. The Pek Kong Cheng Temple at Jalan Pasar in Bukit Mertajam hosts colorful ceremonies on the temple grounds every year. The temple is known for burning the tallest and largest paper statue each year.

Charming Tradition

Charming traditions often have a sense of timelessness, with their origins dating back many years or even centuries since pre-Independence Malaya providing a sense of connection to the past and helping to preserve cultural heritage. They often involve the participation of the wider community, bringing people together in a shared experience. This can create a sense of belonging and unity in today's modern era.

Batu Bersurat Cherok Tok Kun

One of our national treasures is the Batu Bersurat Cherok Tok Kun located in St. Anne's Church near Cherok Tokun hill in Bukit Mertajam. Colonel James Low founded this stone with ancient inscriptions in 1845, and it was then recognised as a national heritage site under the National Heritage Act of 2005.

Pek Kong Cheng

At 136 years old, Pek Kong Cheng temple is one of Malaysia's oldest Chinese temples. A fire in July 2019 damaged the inner shrine, which was surrounded by an exceptional night market, and transformed the essence of the old town. In October 2022, the temple reopened with an upholstered open-air, covered food court serving exquisite curry mee, grilled oyster omelette, and other Chinese street delicacies.

Weng Giap Rattan & Repair

Since its beginnings in 1960, Weng Giap Rattan & Repair has been selling eco-friendly rattan furniture handmade from locally sourced materials. Customers love their traditional chairs, bamboo food covers, steaming baskets, and round rattan shopping baskets.

Capal Jago Gemilang

Capal is a traditional footwear of the Malays that resembles slippers. Capal Jago is a well-known leather sandals manufacturer in Kepala Batas, Seberang Perai. JAGO has been the brand name for sandals for the past 50 years and the first genuine handmade leather sandals.

Tukang Besi, Permatang Benuan

Permatang Benuan's blacksmiths have served as one of Malaysia's oldest steel equipment manufacturers since 1841. They are the sole manufacturers of traditional Malay weapons, which are well-known not just in Penang but across northern Peninsular Malaysia.

The Penang State Government ensures to preserve and protect these important treasured landmarks for future generations.

Tow Boo Kong Temple

The Tow Boo Kong Temple in Butterworth evolved from a tiny shed to a majestic temple over 40 years. It covers 40,000 square feet and is dedicated to Dou Mu, Goddess of the Heavens, and the Nine Emperor Gods.

Heah Swee Lee's Ancestral Mansion, Bukit Tambun

Located next to Liu Siang coffee shop along Jalan Bukit Tambun, Heah Swee Lee's ancestral mansion is a sight to behold in spite of its dilapidated state. This beautiful double-story mansion dates back to the 19th century and had received a minor facelift for a local drama series, called "The Promise".

St Anne Church

The Church of St. Anne is a well-renowned and a century old Roman Catholic church located in Bukit Mertajam and was opened in 1888. Its annual and renowned celebration of the feast of St. Anne which lasts for 10 days every July, regularly attracts over 100,000 pilgrims from neighbouring countries.

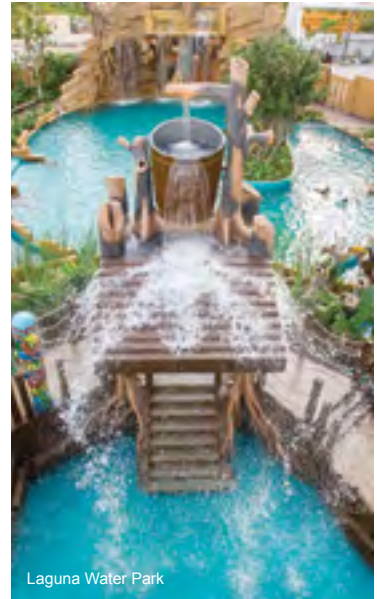

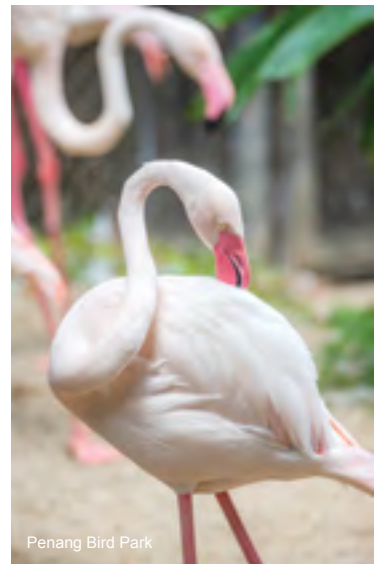
Kampung Agong is a "Agro Themed Park" in the countryside with a coconut grove next to paddy fields. Founded in 1942, the land's founder began to plant the coconut plantation surrounded by paddy fields, which later evolved into an Agro Theme Park. Kampung Agong, which spans 15 acres, launched in 2019 and was named by the land's founder's nickname, "Agong", which was given by the villagers.

And to satisfy your sweet tooth, devour a bowl of ais kacang, a dessert of shaved ice drizzled with palm sugar syrup and topped with tropical fruits and ice cream!

Nasi Kandar

Nasi Kandar is a staple in Penang, usually associated with very long queues of people waiting to indulge in a plate of fluffy rice with meat or seafood, and the signature flooding of the plate with an assortment of curries.

Kopitiam Breakfast

A typical Penang kopitiam (coffee shop) breakfast includes a strong coffee or tea sweetened with sweet condensed milk, two runny half-boiled eggs in a bowl to dip your kaya toast in and colourful bite-sized Nyonya kuih.

Assam Laksa

Assam laksa is an addictive dish of spicy-sour fish broth with noodles, and is listed No. 7 on CNNGo's 'World's 50 Most Delicious Foods'. The tangy secret to this famous noodle dish is a combination of tamarind juice and pieces of asam gelugur.

Malay Cuisine

Throughout Malaysia, Malay cuisine is popular for its nasi lemak and beef rendang, which is a unique combination of many food cultures of Southeast Asia. It is usually very rich in herbs and spices, making it very aromatic and appetising.
